- Paper plates
- Metal yarn needle
- Cookie cutters in various shapes
- Pencil

## Paper Plate Weaving

Practice weaving without breaking the bank! These plates are fun activities for summer camp and parties!

### WEAVING

#### Steps

1. Using cookie cutter of choice, trace shape onto wrong side of plate.
2. Using photo as reference, poke needle through plate, along the line drawn.
3. Cut a 72" [192 cm] piece of yarn. Thread needle with yarn.
4. With needle, stitch pattern from one side of drawn shape to the other. Work in this manner all around shape.
